PHIL HEMPLER DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

The Phil Hempler Award was established in 1986 to honor those outstanding individuals who have served meritoriously as administrators of high school athletics.

The individuals who receive the Phil Hempler award "exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and moral character in their unique and distinguished service to the North Coast Section, C.I.F."

Mr. Hempler's service began in 1929, and he continued to serve high school athletics for 40 years as coach, track official, athletic director, league commissioner, and North Coast Section Commissioner of Athletics (1962 - 1972). For 23 years Phil held the position of Commissioner for the Alameda County Athletic League. Hempler was also Director of Physical Education for the Richmond Unified School District.

Hempler, who passed away in February 1997, was a gentleman whose gracious manner, significant contributions and orderly service to this athletic community are greatly appreciated and long remembered.
